

Education Resource Pack 1: The Newlyn Artists KS1 & 2

The pack comprises background information on the Newlyn artists' colony and short biographies of four specific artists; Walter Langley, Norman Garstin, Elizabeth Adela Forbes and Percy Craft. Four paintings are discussed in the pack and each painting is not just treated as a work of art but also as a record of local and social history. Information is given on what can be seen in the painting, local customs, costume and specific relevant artefacts.

The four paintings are:-

- Scene in a Cornish Fishing Village - Departure of the Fleet for the North by Walter Langley
- The Rain it Raineth Every Day by Norman Garstin
- School is Out by Elizabeth Adela Forbes Nee Armstrong
- Tucking a School of Pilchards by Percy Robert Craft

A4 sized laminated prints of these paintings are included in the pack.

Penlee House usually displays at least two of the above paintings at any specific time and the pack has been designed so that the ideas incorporated in the pack can be adapted to work with many different Newlyn School paintings that can be seen at Penlee House.

The other half of the pack is devoted to ideas that can be used with children pre-, during and post visit, most of which have the relevant QCA references.
